## OREMUS COMMUNICATIONS JUNE 2019 NEWSLETTER

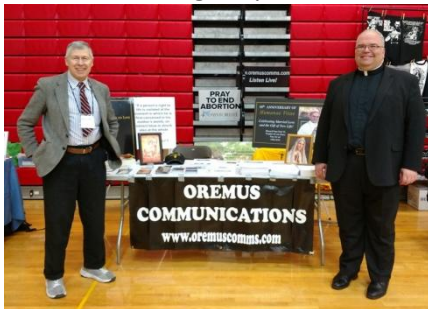
Hello everyone. The month of May and the end of April were full of spiritual activities meant to bring us closer to our Father in Heaven.
